City to Host Groundbreaking Ceremony for Fire Station No. 38

WHO: The City of El Paso

WHAT: Groundbreaking Ceremony for Fire Station No. 38

WHEN: 10:30 a.m. Friday, September 27, 2024

WHERE: Lot near Tim Foster and Pebble Hills

The City of El Paso is excited to announce the groundbreaking ceremony for Fire Station No. 38, a key project under the voter-approved Public Safety Bond. The station will be located in the 14300 block of Pebble Hills Boulevard, adjacent to the new police regional command center.

This state-of-the-art facility will span more than 9,000 square feet and will feature the following services and amenities:

- Three emergency vehicle parking bays with vehicle exhaust ventilation system
- Dispatch office and Information Technology server room
- Medical supply/equipment storage
- Decontamination shower room and unisex restrooms with showers
- Public restrooms, dormitory and industrial laundry facility
- Food preparation/service area, and a cold and dry food storage
- Fitness area and lobby

Construction of the project with an approximate budget of \$5.4 million will be managed by the City's Capital Improvement Department.

The investment is part of the City of El Paso's commitment to maintaining its standing as one of the nation's safest cities, taking proactive approaches to prevent fire/medical incidents, and improving public safety operational efficiencies.
