El Paso Public Libraries Reopens U.S. Passport Facility at Popular Branch Library Applications Resume for those Seeking a Passport

EL PASO, Texas—The City of El Paso Public Libraries is pleased to announce that the U.S. Passport Acceptance Facility is now open at the Dorris Van Doren Branch Library Branch, 551 E. Redd Rd.

The public can access U.S. passport application services without an appointment. The facility had been closed due to the COVID-19 pandemic and library renovations.

The El Paso Public Libraries currently offers passport services at four branch libraries:

- Esperanza Acosta Moreno Branch, 12480 Pebble Hills
- Richard Burges Branch, 9600 Dyer
- Armijo Branch, 620 E. 7th
- Dorris Van Doren Branch, 551 E. Redd

Hours of operation at all the locations are as follows:

- Sunday and Monday: Closed
- Tuesday to Thursday: 10 AM to 4:30 PM
- Friday: 1 to 4:30 PM
- Saturday: 10 AM to 4:30 PM

The passport services at these branch libraries are the only U.S. passport facilities open on Saturday. Appointments are not required; however, necessary documentation is needed to apply for a passport.
