## Shooting on Gary Player

**El Paso, Texas** – On September 3, 2023, around 1:32 a.m., the El Paso Police Department responded to reports of a shooting at a house party at the 10900 block of Gary Player Drive. Officers arrived at the scene to find a large gathering of partygoers dispersing from the backyard of a residence. Officers discovered two victims had sustained gunshot wounds. Victim 1 was found at the scene, provided with medical attention and transported to a local hospital. Victim 2 was located at a local hospital after have being transported by attendees from the party.

Crimes Against Persons Detectives also responded to the scene. The investigation revealed multiple gunshots were fired, resulting in both victims being injured. Arrest warrants were obtained for Luis Ruiz and Alan Villanueva for their involvement. Ruiz and Villanueva were both arrested and booked into the El Paso County Detention Facility. The El Paso Police Department reminds the public to always prioritize safety and avoid altercations, especially at social gatherings. This incident serves as a reminder of the potential dangers that can arise in these situations.
