Suspect Apprehended After Fleeing from Local Authorities

El Paso, Texas – On January 4, 2024, local authorities successfully apprehended suspect Armando Bejarano after fleeing from El Paso Police. Patrol officers attempted a traffic stop at the 8700 Block of Gateway East on a vehicle that had previously been reported as stolen.

Bejarano who was driving the stolen vehicle refused to stop. Officers pursued and monitored the vehicle as it caused property damage at the 9500 Block of Escobar and continued to drive erratically. In a collaborative effort, the Auto Theft Task Force, K9 Units, Customs and Border Patrol Air Unit, and the El Paso Sheriff's Office, joined forces to locate and apprehend Bejarano.

The suspect was ultimately located at the 10800 Block of Robin. The collaboration of law enforcement agencies was instrumental in the successful apprehension, demonstrating our collective dedication to the safety and security of our community.
